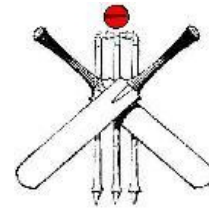

Welcome to Peru! We often say that sarcastically to visitors when they are in a traffic jam but I can assure you that this welcome is heart-felt.

We are extremely proud to be hosting the first *Cricket South America Under-13 Championships* and we hope you all enjoy your time here and the tournament. One thing we are proud of in Lima is the summer weather and we can guarantee there will be no play lost due to rain during the tournament - there hasn't been for the past 150 years.

I take this opportunity to thank the *Lima Cricket and Football Club* for their incredible support of cricket over the past 150 years and their wonderful cricket ground and facilities made available to us for this tournament.

Whilst Cricket may have a long history in Peru, it wasn't until affiliation with the International Cricket Council (ICC) in 2007 that the development of the game has moved to another level. Thanks to the support of the ICC and the work we have started in the past 3-4 years we hope that future senior Peruvian teams contain less 'cricket gringos' and more Peruvian nationals.

Special thanks must go to Martin Viera at ICC Americas and particularly Grant Dugmore as ICC Americas Development officer and now Argentina Cricket CEO, for their support in our ICC status. Senior Cricket in Peru has also developed over the past 4 years and we now have four 'clubs' in Lima; 'Kiteflyers', 'Eidgenossen', 'Chak De' and 'Lima Cricket'. In 2010 for the first time a league has been played between reserve teams from each club giving us 8 teams in the national league. Cricket is also played in Cusco and Tacna (in the south). We hope that in the future (as has already started to happen) the juniors take their place in the senior teams of these clubs.

Extraordinary Tournament rules

T20 (20 Overs per team) Tournament

- Normal T20 rules BUT not including fielding restrictions.

'Cricket Veloz' (7-a-side) Tournament

- Each team shall consist of 7 players
- Each team shall bowl 6 overs per innings, each bowled by a different player.
- Wides/no balls shall count as 2 runs and the ball shall not be re-bowled (except for the final over of the innings where they must be re-bowled)
