

### **Sat, April 2<sup>nd</sup> – Kites v LCFC**

The Kites v LCFC game on Saturday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> can really be defined by one innings: Louis Grandjean, batting at #3 for LCFC, hit 112 from 52 balls to secure a total of 202 for 2, at the end of 20 overs, to ensure that the Kites would not be able to repeat the painful defeat they had inflicted on LCFC earlier in the season. What was more remarkable about this is that, at the end of the 13<sup>th</sup> over, the score was only 55 for 2 - and young James King's four-over spell had yielded only 4 runs, with 3 maidens and 1 wicket!

In reply, Kites managed to reach 145 for 5, with Ed Baxter (56\*) hitting his maiden half century to make up for his bowling figures. Again the bowling was tight by LCFC and with regular wickets the unlikely scoreline was calmly defended. The Guns of Lima Cricket had really fired this time.
